



Borough of Somerdale Energy Aggregation Program (EAP) Announcement

January 16, 2021

Dear Borough of Somerdale Resident:

The Borough of Somerdale Energy Aggregation Program (EAP) will launch in March of 2021 with the goal of using the Borough's bulk-purchasing power to procure electric power **supply** on behalf of Borough residents at a lower price than power supply provided by Atlantic City Electric (ACE). The borough of Somerdale has solicited price proposals from competing suppliers on several occasions in the hopes of awarding a contract that is beneficial for its residents.

We are pleased to inform you that as a result of the Borough's most recent bid process, the Borough has awarded a contract to the low bidder, Great American Gas & Electric, LLC (GAGE), for a 22-month contract beginning in March 2021 for residential account holders who are located in ACE service territory. The new contract with GAGE will provide electric supply at a rate that is nearly five (5) percent lower than the current rate being paid by those residents currently receiving supply through ACE. Savings are estimated and will vary when compared to your utility tariff prices which will increase and/or decrease over the course of the Program.

GAGE is an electric supplier licensed by the state of New Jersey, has been in business since 2019, having experience serving other residential customers through energy aggregation programs like the Borough of Somerdale EAP. If you do not wish to participate in the Borough of Somerdale EAP, you can opt out by following the instructions provided in the Program Summary on the reverse side of this notice. If you do not opt out of the Borough of Somerdale EAP, you will receive an additional notification from ACE in March that your account is being automatically enrolled with the new Borough of Somerdale EAP supplier, GAGE, effective with your March 2021 meter read.

The Energy Aggregation Program is only for the energy **supply portion** of your electric service. The delivery portion will continue to be provided by ACE at regulated rates. ACE will continue to provide all routine, emergency and safety services. ACE will also continue to provide customer services such as meter readings, billing, and service restoration. If you are on an ACE budget billing plan/equal payment plan, you will not be automatically included in the Program. You will instead, continue to receive service directly from ACE unless you opt into the Program. You may opt into the Program by contacting GAGE directly. ***Please review the enclosed materials and familiarize yourself with this program.***

If you do not opt out by <u>February 16, 2021</u>, you will be automatically enrolled. However, at any time thereafter, you may leave the Borough of Somerdale EAP with no associated fees. <i>You may also opt out through the Borough's Energy Consultant at 1-800-625-1528.</i>
Program Start Date:	Service will begin with your March 2021 meter read date
Program Term/Length:	22 months, from your March 2021 meter read date until your January 2023 meter read date
Cancellation/Early Termination Fees:	None. You can opt out at any time, with no penalty or cancellation fee.
Renewal Terms:	No automatic roll-over or renewal. If a new contract is awarded by the Borough, you will be notified, provided a new Program Summary, and will again be given the opportunity to participate in the Program or opt out. If no new contract is awarded by the Borough, program participants will be returned to ACE supply service in January 2023.

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Residents receiving this notice who are outside the jurisdictional boundaries of the borough of Somerdale, please contact GAGE to be removed from the Program. Somerdale residents who do not receive this notice are permitted to join the Program any time.

¹Supplier cannot vary prices monthly or adjust prices for changed market conditions or change the rate after an initial 'teaser' period. The price will remain unchanged for the full contract term. The only exception is a one-time contract price adjustment resulting from a change in law that also affects the cost of power supply provided by ACE, in which case the contract price adjustment will not adversely impact the level of savings as compared to the ACE tariff price for power supply.
